- 17:00 Close

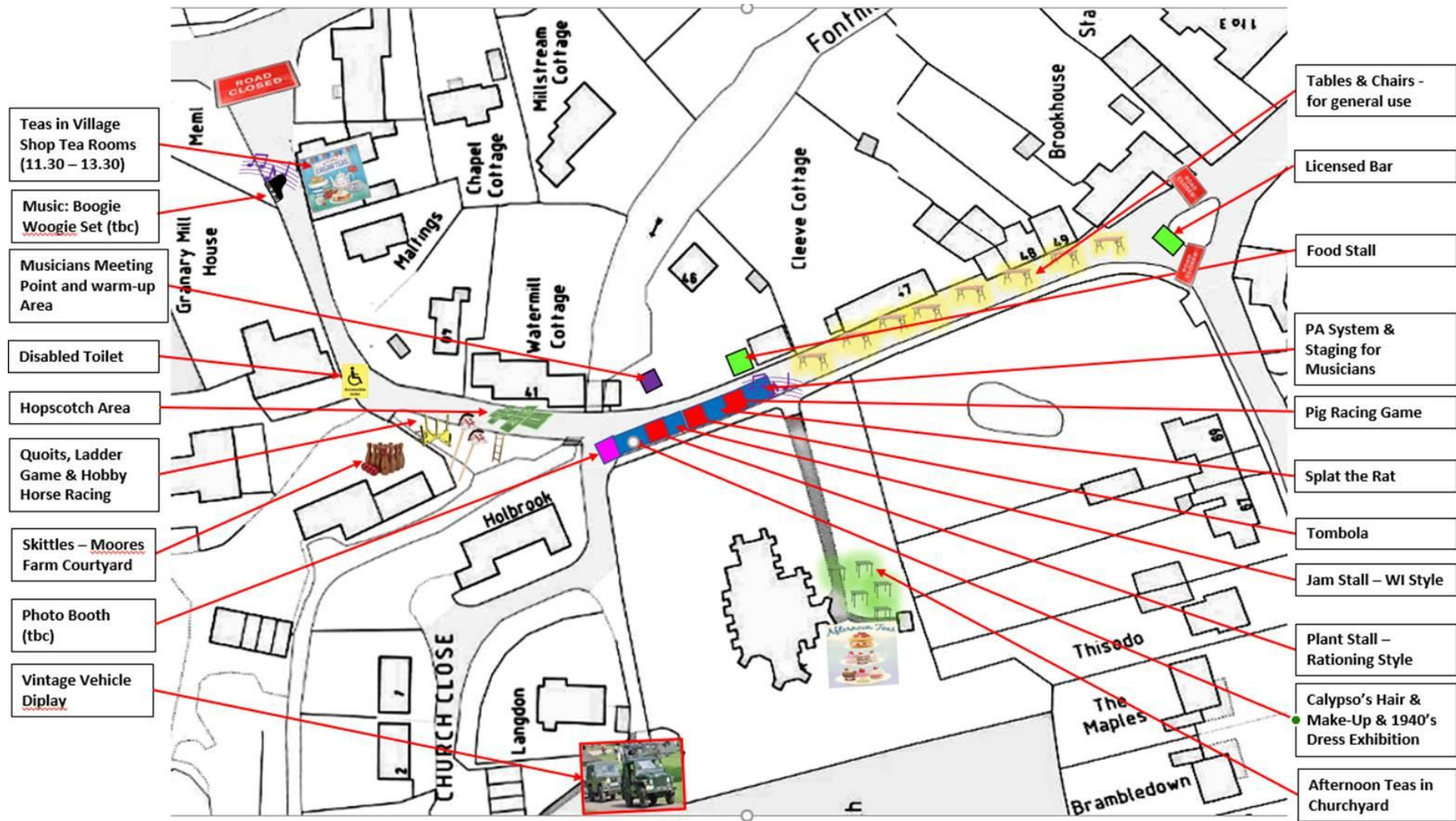
