

Fontmell Magna Neighbourhood Plan

Re. Document from Bluebridge Communications

Dear Resident,

The Fontmell Magna Parish Council (PC) and the Fontmell Magna Neighbourhood Plan Working Group (“Working Group”) are aware that a document from Bluebridge Communications, commissioned by a "number of concerned parties" who have chosen to remain anonymous, has been sent to each household in the parish, addressed to "The Occupier". The document was not sent to the Parish Council nor to the Working Group. Both the PC and the Working Group have been approached by residents asking for advice.

The Neighbourhood Plan Working Group wish to make the following points of clarification:

- The Bluebridge Communications document has been issued independently of the Working Group and is not endorsed by the Working Group.
- In preparing the Neighbourhood Plan, the Working Group is following a rigorous, fair and transparent process, where parish residents are consulted and asked for feedback at all major decision points.
- All meeting notes of the Working Group and all important documents associated with the Neighbourhood Plan are published on the parish council website: www.fontmellmagnapc.co.uk.
- The next stage in preparing the Neighbourhood Plan is the publication of a Draft Plan document which will be available to all residents. It will be explained in consultation events where your feedback will be requested; the consultation will also be available online. We expect to issue the Draft Plan in September.

As the Bluebridge Communications document was addressed to the Occupier of each property it is up to that person to determine how they wish to respond.

This matter will also be considered by the Parish Council at its next meeting on 10th July where residents can raise any further concerns they may have.
