



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SUTTON CLUMP, SUTTON WALDRON

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along SUTTON CLUMP, SUTTON WALDRON (just off of the C13, Higher Blandford / Shaftesbury Road), for a distance of approximately 75 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It came into operation on Monday 17 July 2017 and remain in force for 21 days. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed by Monday 31 July 2017.

This Notice will enable Southern Electric safe access to carry out emergency repairs to a defective 11KV electricity cable.

Alternative routes which will be sign posted around Sutton Clump, as indicated in blue on the following map.
