

URGENT TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C13 BOYNE'S LANE, IWERNE MINSTER

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along C13 Boyne's Lane, Iwerne Minster between Boyne's Lane to Furzey Down Farm, Iwerne Minster and Smugglers Lane, Stourpaine, a distance of approximately 2550 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 09:30 - 15:30 on 9th September 2024 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20th September 2024

This Order will enable Ranston Farms safe access to carry out urgent works to fell ash dieback trees.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
