

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DINAHS HOLLOW, MELBURY ABBAS (NIGHT WORK)

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along DINAHS HOLLOW, MELBURY ABBAS between the junctions of White Pit Lane and the B308 - Higher Blandford Road (in both directions), a distance of approximately 1315 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on the 28th March 2022 between 20:00 and 06:00 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 31st March 2022. The closure will be lifted during the day.

This Notice will enable KN Group agents of Openreach safe access to carry out and lay new track, build new boxes, access to underground structures and overhead cables in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Spread Eagle Hill - Boyne's Lane - Higher Shaftesbury Road - A350 - B3081
