e.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with one standard ash in same position.							
We are implementing a plan to restore our North Orchard. We need to ensure it is safe for visiting school children and other users and replant extensively with new fruit trees to enable organic fruit production again. To facilitate this we need to fell white poplars numbered 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,11,13,19,21 on the site plan that are over mature, over hanging and currently render the whole area unusable due to dangerous falling branches. In addition we also need to crown lift trees numbered 10,12,14,15,16,17,18,20,22,23,24,25 on the north easterly secondary and tertiary side laterals to remove excessive overhanging/shading while also retaining wind firmness. Felled stumps will be retained and incorporated into a new hedgerow with walnut, lime, beech, rowan and field maple used to replace the felled poplars. The existing fruit trees will be retained where possible with extensive replanting of dead/damaged/missing ones with local varieties of apple, pear, cherry and plum. The remainder of the poplars will be felled in approximately 5-10 years time when the new plantings have had a chance to establish in the landscape.
